## Steps to Enable Ping & Fps in Valorant

- Open up the game, and upon entering the lobby click on the gear icon on the top-right most portion of the screen.
- 2. Click on settings. You'll be taken to General tab by default go to Video Settings.
- 3. While on the Video Settings, you will be shown with another 3 options.
- 4. Open up the stats under the Video Settings.
- 5. Enable "Client FPS" to show game fps and for the ping

the options that you can enable are "Server Tick Rate", "Network Round Trip Time" and "Packet Loss".
