How to export chat / files history in Skype (2020)

In this short tutorial, I'll be showing you how you can export chat or conversation / files history in Skype. Before, this option was available through the skype desktop app however it was updated to a more secure process which requires web-based request of files and chat history compared to app-based requests.

How to read the .json files?

To extract the .tar file on Windows 10:

- 1. Press the Windows + r keys on your keyboard to open the Run window.
- 2. In the Open: field, type cmd and then click OK.
- 3. Use the "change directory" (CD) command to navigate to your file:
 - Files saved to your Downloads folder: Type CD Downloads and then presh Enter.
 - Files saved to a location other than your downloads folder: Type CD DIRECTORY, replacing DIRECTORY with the folder name where your exported file was saved. (IE: CD Desktop), and then press Enter.

- 4. Type tar -xvfYOURFILENAME_export.tar, replacing YOURFILENAME with the name of your exported file which usually follows the pattern 8_skypename_export.tar or 8 live skypename export.tar and then press Enter.
- 5. After the command completes, you will see your extracted messages file named **messages.json** file in the directory. We recommend downloading the file <u>viewer</u> to make is easier to read your conversation history.
- 6. After downloading the <u>viewer</u>, open it by selecting the **index.html** file from the skype-parser folder.
- 7. Browse to the messages.json file and then click the **Load** button.

To extract the .tar file on Mac

Browse to the .tar file you downloaded and open the file. Mac has built-in .tar support.
