## Step-by-Step Guide

1. Open up a file explorer and type on the address bar **%appdata%**.
2. Click the back icon or go one directory backwards that will take you outside the appdata roaming folder.
3. Open up "local" folder then look for Microsoft folder.
4. Scroll down until you see the "Windows" folder and open it up.
5. Download WinX files by clicking on the download button above.
6. Extract WinX files / folder to corresponding WinX folder placed under the opened Windows folder.
7. Replace all files (Group 1, Group2, Group 3) to fix any corrupted shortcut files and configurations.

8. Open up task manager, then restart Windows Explorer or simply restart your computer.
